

# SaskTel Outside Work Opportunities

**Be part of a team. Be challenged. Learn.**

SaskTel isn't only about computers, high tech networks and administration. There are many areas of the company that require demanding, physical work along with the enjoyment of spending some time outdoors. Safety is paramount at SaskTel and anyone employed in these areas is appropriately equipped and trained to perform the job safely.

Think this would be of interest to you? Here are a few examples of what your responsibilities might include in an Outside Work position. Your exact role will depend on where you are located, and what area you are assigned to, but you need to be prepared to perform any of the activities outlined below.

## Locations where outside work is required:

- Regina
- Saskatoon
- Prince Albert
- Swift Current
- Estevan
- Weyburn
- Yorkton
- North Battleford

## Types of buildings where outside work takes place:

- Small Equipment Building – contains the switch for towns and farms
- Radio Building – Mobility cellular sites across the province
- Customer Service Centre building – a SaskTel work centre for employees working in the district (such as Davidson, Radville, Weyburn, Estevan).

## Range of responsibilities:

- operate floor polisher and/or stripper
- load/remove equipment onto a truck (40 to 60 pounds)
- handle/mount/change spare tires (approx 83 pounds)
- cut grass or bush (with push or ride-on equipment)
- move/load ladders onto vehicles and buildings
- inspect, repair and/or replace shingles
- operating trucks, equipment, trailers and tractors
- scoop/spread gravel
- spray chemical for weed control – mix, fill and operate sprayers
- paint



## Other considerations:

- frequently you will be required to work alone (within strict safety guidelines)
- northern living accommodations may require two persons to share a room
- may be required to stay in a small community for a period of time
- must pass a pesticides course if required for the job
- must possess physical ability to do the work required -- to change mower blades, flat tires, secure equipment to trailers, lift equipment from vehicles and move materials/equipment, etc.
