5. An applicant may not market the brand names or marks of SaskTel and or DirectWest.
6. The applicant agrees that all information provided pursuant to this tariff may only be used for the sole purpose of creating independent directories and or providing directory assistance services. The applicant may not use any information provided pursuant to this tariff for telemarketing purposes. For the purpose of this tariff, telemarketing shall include but not be restricted to the promotion, by the applicant or by any person or entity, of the applicant or its services or products, or of any third party or its services or products, by any means.

1. Update files are only provided in association with a master file of the same exchanges or NXXs and must be requested at the same time as the master file.
2. Customized features is defined as the initial subscription to government, business or residence listings on a separate basis and/or the initial subscription to a partial list of NXXs from an exchange.
3. Service reconfiguration is defined as a change to the current subscription.
