Competitive Payphone Toll-Free Tracking Report Service

1. Service Description

The Competitive Payphone Toll-Free Tracking (CPTT) Report Service provides Competitive Pay Telephone Service Providers (CPTSPs), or an agent representing multiple CPTSPs, with a report of billing information required to bill IXCs for toll-free calls originating from CPTSP pay telephones that are connected to SaskTel's network via Pay Telephone Basic Access Line (PALs) Service obtained from SaskTel.

The report will include each toll-free number called, the number of times that the toll-free number was called, the total number of toll-free calls generated, and the name of the IXC over whose network the toll-free calls were routed.

2. Conditions of Service

- 1. The CPTT Report is an optional monthly report available to CPTSPs that subscribe to SaskTel's Pay Telephone Basic Access Line Service, or to an agent representing CPTSPs that are connected to SaskTel's network via PALs obtained from SaskTel.
- 2. The CPTSP or agent representing CPTSPs, must sign a non-disclosure agreement with SaskTel assuring that the billing information provided on the CPTT Report shall only be used for the sole purpose of billing the IXCs, and will not be disclosed to any other party or for any other purpose.
- 3. At the request of the CPTSP or agent representing the CPTSP, SaskTel will provide billing information on an originating exchange basis.
