1. Service Description

Digital Network Access provides for the digital transmission of information from the customer's premises to another premises within the exchange at 1.544 Mbps or 44.736 Mbps, or from the customer's premises to the rate centre to connect with other network services at speeds of less than 1.544 Mbps, 1.544 Mbps or 44.736 Mbps.

Note: Effective June 1, 2002, SaskTel's competitors see also Competitor Digital Network Access Service in SaskTel Competitor Access Tariff (CRTC 21414), if applicable.


2. Conditions of Service

- 1. SaskTel will determine the exchanges (i.e., rate centre and/or wire centre, as appropriate) where it will provide service.
- 2. Service is provided at SaskTel's discretion within such exchanges depending on the availability of suitable facilities and equipment.
- 3. When it is necessary for SaskTel to install special equipment or to incur an unusual expense to establish service, the Customer shall pay an additional charge based on the equipment installed and the unusual expense incurred.
- 4. The Customer is solely responsible for the installation, operation and maintenance of customer provided terminal equipment.
- 5. Customer terminal equipment attached to SaskTel's network must be certified or connected through a certified network protection device in accordance with SaskTel's Terminal Attachment Standards.

- 6. If the customer is located outside the base rate boundary or island base rate boundary of a serving exchange area, an extra construction charge will apply in addition to the service charges listed in this item. Refer to the item on Extended Data Access Charge.
- 7. For the provision of DS-1 and DS-3 access, wire centres in SaskTel territory are categorized according to bands depicting serving area. The exchanges of Regina and Saskatoon shall be classified as Band 2 serving areas. All other locations in Saskatchewan, where the service is available, shall be classified as Band 3 serving areas.
- 8. The calculation of DS-1 and DS-3 access quantity discounts is subject to the following conditions. All DS-1 and DS-3 accesses must:
 - (a) be billed on the same account (Billing Telephone Number (BTN)),
 - (b) be part of the same Minimum Contract Period (MCP) commitment (i.e., same agreement and same term, and
 - (c) terminate at the same customer premises.
- 9. When a channel is between the serving switching centre or island base rate boundary and the rate centre, a Link charge applies at the serving switching centre or island base rate area and rate centre.
- 10. A DS-1 channelizing feature is available whenever the service application requires one which enables a DS-1 Access or channel to be connected to DS-0 channels. The use of this feature will result in a service charge being applied to activate and interconnect unused DS-0 capacity within a DS-1 Access or channel.

- 11. A DS-3 channelizing feature is available whenever the service application requires one, which enables a DS-3 access or channel to be connected to DS-1 channels. The use of this feature will result in service charges, being applied to activate and interconnect unused DS-1 capacity within a DS-3 access or channel.
- 12. If the customer terminates a contract or a portion of a contract for local DS-1 Access Service or DS-3 Access Service prior to the expiry date of the contract term, termination charges equal to one half of the remaining charges for such DS-1 Access Service or DS-3 Access Service for the unexpired part of the contract will be payable in a single payment at the termination of the contract.
- 13. Termination charges for DS-1 and DS-3 access services will be reduced or waived if the customer re-contracts for another dedicated access service within SaskTel's operating territory.
 - (a) If the committed revenues under the new contract(s) are equal to or greater than those remaining under the original contract(s), the termination charges for the original contract(s) will be waived.
 - (b) If the committed revenues under the new contract(s) are less than those remaining under the original contract(s), the termination charges for the original contract(s) will be reduced by half the committed revenues under the new contract(s).
- 14. The reduction or waiver of termination charges as specified above will apply if the contracted DS-1 Access:
 - (a) is reconfigured between one of Digital Private Line/Managed Digital Private Line, Toll service and/or Frame Relay; or
 - (b) in moved to another address within the installation order interval for SaskTel.

3. Rates

The Customer shall pay to SaskTel the following rates and charges for Digital Network Access (DNA). Such rates and charges are in addition to any other rates and charges that may be applicable.

1. Low Speed Access

The following, Access, Link and Intra-exchange Channel rates and charges apply when used with the following services:

- Digital Private Line Solutions Service Extension Access Service for speeds up to DS-0.
- FME Access (Refer to the item on Managed Digital Private Line Service) for speeds up to DS-0 and Managed Digital Private Line Terminating Unit (MDPLTU) Access (Refer to the item on Managed Digital Private Line Service) for 2 times 64 Kbps or 1 times 128 Kbps.
- Frame Relay Access at DS-0
- International Private Line Service for speeds up to DS-0.
- Other services as identified in the respective SaskTel tariffs.
