100.30      **Extended Area Service (EAS)**

**Note:** The residence and business service elements of this item are forborne from regulation in certain exchanges, as identified in Item 100.21 and Item 100.23, respectively.

|**1. Service Description**

Extended Area Service (EAS) is a service arrangement that allows all customers in one exchange area to call or to be called by all customers in one or more adjacent exchange areas without a long distance charge.

**2. Conditions of Service**

1. The V&H coordinate distance between the exchange centres of those requesting EA must not exceed 48 kilometers (30 miles).
2. EAS will continue to be the standard offering in exchanges with EAS.
3. EAS surcharges apply to each residence and business individual line service (ILS), Centrex line service, Centrex data service, Microlink, and payphone access lines.
4. For multi-line access, each access/trunk is assessed one EAS surcharge.
