**1. Service Description**

This service provides the Customer with a blended Centrex Service rate and termination options for a customer that is anticipating centralizing their business.

**2. Definitions**

**Reference:** Refer to the item on currently offered Centrex Service II for Definitions.

**3. Conditions of Service**

Unless specifically noted otherwise, Conditions of Service for this item are set out in SaskTel's Tariff Item on currently offered Centrex Service II.

1. The customer must have a minimum of 1710 Centrex network access lines in the province of Saskatchewan.
2. The customer must sign a contract for a fixed term of 5 years. The rate represents a blended rate calculated as a weighted average, that has been calculated on the basis of the actual number of telephone lines located in the Downtown Core of Regina and Saskatoon (\$24.80 per month as long as a minimum of 250 lines are maintained in each location) and the number of telephone lines located elsewhere in the province.

Once every 6 months during the term of the Agreement, the actual number of telephone lines located in the two aforesaid rate bands shall be added up and a new blended rate struck, which rate will be in force until a new blended rate is recalculated in accordance with this provision. The blended rate shall be calculated each time in accordance with the methodology used to calculate the initial blended rate.

**3. Conditions of Service – Continued**

3. In the event there is a reduction in the customer's business operations which results in a decreased requirement for telephone lines and such reduction has occurred either:
- (a) as a result of the customer centralizing its business operations with the result that branch offices are closed or
  - (b) as a result of a decision to reduce the size of the operations of the customer as part of an effort to improve the operating efficiency of their business,

the minimum number of telephone lines may be reduced by up to 50% without incurring termination charges. In the event the minimum number of telephone lines is reduced by more than 50%, termination charges shall apply in accordance with the current Centrex Service II tariff for the number of telephone lines below the 50% threshold.

4. Regardless of the waiver of termination charges as provided herein, in the event the total number of telephone lines remaining after the reduction is such that the rates that would have been charged for that volume of telephone lines when this contract was first entered into by the parties is higher than that provided in this Agreement, the monthly charges for the remaining number of telephone lines shall revert to the charges which would have been applicable when this Agreement was first entered into by the parties.
